COMMISSIONER COURT MINUTES MARCH 22, 2021

1. Proof of posting of notice in accordance with the provisions of Title 5, Chapter 551, Government Code (Vernon's Texas Codes Ann. 1994) as amended, known as the Texas Open Meetings Act.

Judge Elliott asked for proof of posting& the same was affirmed by Elizabeth Perez, County Clerk, on the front door and on the bulletin board.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to pay bills, budget amendments & payroll. Commissioner Green seconded. Motion carried.


18. Approval of minutes of prior meetings of Commissioner's Court.
