

INVITATION FOR BIDS ON THE FALLS COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND JAIL

The proposals are for various items of work to repair hail damage to equipment and the building occupied by the Falls County Sheriff's Department and Jail. The scope of work will include:

- EIFS repair on building exterior.
- Replacement of RTU's
- Replacement of exhaust fan hoods.
- Installation of edge trim, gutters, and down spouts.

Contractors may propose on the work in its entirety or on specific items.

Falls County will receive sealed competitive proposals until August 21, 2020 at 3:00 p.m. Proposals should be delivered to the County Judge's office by or prior to 3:00 p.m. on August 21, 2020. Proposals will be opened in Commissioner's Court at 9:00 a.m., on August 24, 2020, or the next scheduled Commissioner's Court meeting. **Proposals may be hand delivered or mailed to Jay T. Elliott, Falls County Judge, P.O. Box 458, Marlin, Texas 76661, and should be clearly marked on the outside of the envelope what the proposal is for.**

The County will select proposals based upon "Best Value". All inquiries and instructions will be issued through the County Judge's office.
