This notice provides information about two tax rates used in adopting the current tax year's tax rate. The no-new-revenue tax rate would Impose the same amount of taxes as last year if you compare properties taxed in both years. In most cases, the voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate a taxing unit can adopt without holding an election. In each case, these rates are calculated by dividing the total amount of taxes by the current taxable value with adjustments as required by state law. The rates are given per \$100 of property value.

State Criminal Justice Mandate

The Falls County County Auditor certifies that Falls County County has spent \$30,954 in the previous 12 months for the maintenance and operations cost of keeping inmates sentenced to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. Falls County County Sheriff has provided Falls County information on these costs, minus the state revenues received for reimbursement of such costs. This increased the voter-approval rate by 0.00266/\$100.

Indigent Health Care Compensation Expenditures

The Falls County spent \$126,339 from July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 on enhanced indigent health care at the increased minimum eligibility standards, less the amount of state assistance. For the current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's enhanced indigent health care expenditures is \$126,339. This increased the voter-approval rate by 0.01386/\$100.
