**DECLARATION OF DISASTER**

**For**

**Falls County, Texas**

WHEREAS, the County of Falls on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2026, has suffered widespread or severe damage resulting from significant weather events, extreme rainfall, and flooding through the county and;

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Falls has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF FALLS COUNTY:

1. That a state of disaster is hereby declared for Falls County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Falls County.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Falls County emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
