COMMISSIONER'S COURT MINUTES FOR JULY 13, 2026

1. Proof of posting of notice in accordance with the provisions of Title 5, Chapter 551, Government Code (Vernon's Texas Codes Ann. 1994) as amended, known as the Texas Open Meetings Act.

NOTICE: At any point in the meeting, the Commissioner's Court may, with no further public notice, call for an immediate Closed Meeting, otherwise known as an Executive Session, to seek legal advice in a private consultation on any matter in which a duty of the attorney for the governmental body requires attorney-client privilege, per TEX. GOV'T CODE 551.071.

Judge Elliott called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. Judge Elliott asked for proof of posting and the same was affirmed by Elizabeth Perez, County Clerk, on the north and south door and the bulletin board.

2. Public comments.

No public comments.

3. Elected official reports.

Commissioner Green stated that he will be returning \$300 for an indigent cremation from last month. The reimbursement is due to an error in which the cremation was mistakenly submitted as an oversized cremation when it was a standard cremation.

Commissioner Wuebker had a question regarding the open position at the Sheriff's Department. She wanted to know if they were replacing someone that had left or it for new patrol officers. Sheriff Campbell clarified that it they were replacing people.

4. Approval of minutes of prior meetings of Commissioner's Court.

Commissioner Wuebker made a motion to approve the minutes of the prior meeting. Commissioner Willberg seconded; motion passed unanimously.

5. Discussion concerning A&M AgriLife Extension Service & Prairie View A&M Cooperative Extension Service annual report.

Pasquale Swaner, County Extension Agent, presented the Agriculture & 4-H Report. Cayson Newell also shared his accomplishments with us.

6. Discussion and/or action concerning Interlocal Agreement for Assessment and Collection of Taxes.

Commissioner Wuebker made a motion to approve the Interlocal Agreement for Assessment and Collection of Taxes for ESD #1, Rosebud-Lott ISD, and City of Rosebud. Commissioner Willberg seconded; motion passed unanimously.

7. Discussion and approval of compensatory time payout for one (1) Sheriff Deputy.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to approve the payout for one (1) Sheriff Deputy. Commissioner Green seconded; motion passed unanimously.

8. Discussion and/or action concerning interlocal agreement with Marlin ISD for millings from TXDOT.

Jeff Jackson, Road and Bridge Administrator, will check to see if he is able to get millings from TXDOT.

9. Discussion and/or action concerning cement work for sidewalks, concrete drive and curbs, 50% payment.

Commissioner Green made a motion to approve the 50% payment for the cement work. Commissioner Willberg seconded; motion passed unanimously.

10. Discussion and/or action concerning purchase of two radios for county jail out of commissary account.

Commissioner Green made a motion to approve the purchase of two radios for county jail out of the commissary account. Commissioner Albright seconded; motion passed unanimously.

11. Discussion and/or action concerning purchase of felony folders for DA's Office.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to approve the purchase of felony folders for DA's office. Commissioner Green seconded; motion passed unanimously.

12. Discussion and/or action concerning Transunion annual renewal agreement.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to approve the Transunion annual renewal agreement. Commissioner Green seconded; motion passed unanimously.

13. Discussion and/or action concerning lawn mower for the Sheriff's Department.

Commissioner Green made a motion to approve the purchase of a lawn mower for the Sheriff's Department with payment coming out of inmate welfare and commissary. Commissioner Albright seconded; motion passed unanimously.

14. Discussion and/or action concerning going out for bids for Gasoline, Diesel Fuel, and Motor Oil; Scalping, White Rock, and Fine and/or product no. 2 screenings for road base; Road Oil, Asphalt, & Emulsion; Transporting and Delivery of Road Materials; Bridge Materials/Treated Lumber; Bridge Materials/New or Used Steel or Iron; replacing 20-, 40-, and 60-foot bridges; and Culverts.

Commissioner Willberg made a motion to go out for bids for Gasoline, Diesel Fuel, and Motor Oil; Scalping, White Rock, and Fine and/or product no. 2 screenings for road base; Road Oil, Asphalt, & Emulsion; Transporting and Delivery of Road Materials; Bridge Materials/Treated Lumber; Bridge Materials/New or Used Steel or Iron; replacing 20-, 40-, and 60-foot bridges; and Culverts. Commissioner Green seconded; motion passed unanimously.

15. Discussion and/or action concerning bridge replacement on CR 273.

Commissioner Green made a motion to approve the replacement of the bridge on CR 273. Commissioner Albright seconded; motion passed unanimously.

16. Review and discussion of Road and Bridge precinct work reports, including Administrator's progress report.

Jeff Jackson, Road and Bridge Administrator, gave a report for the Road and Bridge Department. Jeff stated that he will have one person out on medical leave, he has one Class A driver position open and he has lots of equipment that is down right now. Jeff stated that at the beginning of budget he wants to purchase a tire shredder.

17. Discussion and/or action concerning the approving of payment of bills, including reimbursements, late charges, the transfer of cash or funds from any line item or departments to another, book transfers and any budget amendments; including but not limited to discussion and action concerning department or non-departmental items with line items that go past their budgeted amounts.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to approve the payment of all bills, budget amendments, and payroll. Commissioner Wuebker seconded; motion carried.

18. Discussion concerning any upcoming agenda items.

Budget will begin on August 3, 2026. We will have meetings on August 7th, 10th, 13th, 17th, and 21st.

19. Adjournment.

Judge Elliott adjourned the meeting at 9:34 a.m., after all items had been discussed.
