26. Adjournment.

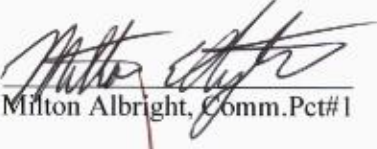
Judge Elliott adjourned the meeting at 9:53 a.m., after all items had been discussed.
