COMMISSIONER'S COURT MINUTES FOR SEPTEMBER 22, 2025

1. Proof of posting of notice in accordance with the provisions of Title 5, Chapter 551, Government Code (Vernon's Texas Codes Ann. 1994) as amended, known as the Texas Open Meetings Act.

Judge Elliott asked for proof of posting and the same was affirmed by Elizabeth Perez, County Clerk, on the north and south door and the bulletin board.

2. Public comments.

4. Discussion and/or action concerning American Rescue Plan.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to sign the Code of Conduct Policy, Financial Management Policies & Procedures, Document Management & Records Retention Policy, and ARPA Anti-Fraud Waste & Abuse Plan; sign the addendum for the contract and deobligate and reclassify ARPA funds. Commissioner Wuebker seconded; motion carried.

5. Discussion and/or action concerning contract for Hazard Mitigation Action Plan Project.

Commissioner Green made a motion to accept the contract with MBW Management for Hazard Mitigation Action Plan Project. Commissioner Albright seconded; motion carried.

6. Discussion and/or action concerning the results of the TCEQ complaints filed by a resident on CR 332.

Commissioner Willberg stated there were a couple of TCEQ complaints filed by a resident on CR 332. Commissioner Willberg stated that the results came back good. Nothing was found in the investigation of the complaints.

Judge Elliott adjourned the meeting at 10:03 a.m., after all items had been discussed.

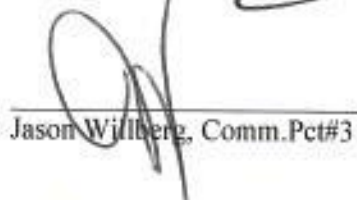
