COMMISSIONER'S COURT MINUTES JANUARY 26, 2026

The Falls County Judge called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, January 26, 2026. The meeting was recessed due to lack of a quorum.

The meeting was reconvened at 9:00 a.m. with a quorum present.

1. Proof of posting of notice in accordance with the provisions of Title 5, Chapter 551, Government Code (Vernon's Texas Codes Ann. 1994) as amended, known as the Texas Open Meetings Act. Deputy County Clerk Sharon Scott indicated that the agenda had been posted on the north and south doors of the courthouse, as well as the second floor bulletin board and the Falls County website.
2. Public comments.
No public comments were made.
3. Elected official reports.
Commissioner Green noted that the United Sports League (there are four teams in Marlin) had received their 501c. He noted that each of the teams won their Super Bowl this year. In the future, when there are funds to be provided for such organizations, they will be able to be included.
4. Discussion and/or action concerning the resale of trust property PID 38769 (17.55-acre tract, more or less) to Amanda V. Lee for the original tax sale opening bid of \$60,305, subject to post-judgment taxes (i.e., the 2024-2025 tax years) being paid pursuant to an installment plan with the tax office.
Commissioner Albright moved to approve the sale; Commissioner Green seconded. The vote was unanimous.
5. Discussion and/or action concerning elevator.
The technician will not be here until February 2. The bill that is currently awaiting payment was from maintenance done December 12.
6. Discussion and/or action concerning House Bill 3000.
Following a brief discussion regarding the ambulance grant, F. A. Green moved to permit the Judge to sign the application, grant and resolution. Milton Albright seconded. Motion carried.
7. Discussion and/or action concerning homeland security.
There was discussion regarding the inability to determine exactly the rules and regulations for SB8. Neither the Judge nor Auditor had been able to see them.
8. Discussion and/or action concerning appointing County Judge Pro Tem.
Commissioner Green moved to appoint Commissioner Albright as Judge Pro Tem. Commissioner Wilberg seconded the motion. The motion carried.
9. Discussion and/or action concerning resolution for Youth Victim Services for 2027.
Commissioner Wuebker moved to approve the resolution. Commissioner Albright seconded. Motion carried.
10. Discussion and/or action concerning resolution for Youth Intervention Services for 2027.
Nita Wuebker moved to approve the resolution; Milton Albright seconded. Motion carried.

11. Discussion and/or action concerning camera system at the Chilton Annex.
Following a brief discussion, Commissioner Green moved to accept the \$2850 fee for replacement of in-house equipment while our current one is being refurbished under warranty. Commissioner Albright seconded. Motion carried.
12. Discussion and/or action concerning OEM outdoor fan motor for county jail.
Milton Albright moved to approve the OEM outdoor fan motor for the jail. F. A. Green seconded. Motion carried.
13. Discussion and/or action concerning quote for new TLETS computer for county jail.
F. A. Green moved to approve the quote for the TLETS computer for the county jail. Milton Albright seconded. Motion carried.
14. Discussion and/or action concerning heating/cooling unit for Sheriff's Offices.
Commissioner Green moved to approve the Pomykal quote. Commissioner Albright seconded. Motion carried.
15. Discussion and/or action concerning inmate healthcare.
Following a discussion of the costs and hours provided, Commissioner Green moved to accept the bid from Orms Family Medicine, MD PA. Commissioner Willberg seconded. Motion carried.
16. Discussion and/or action concerning interlocal agreement with Chilton ISD.
No action taken
17. Discussion and/or action concerning county investments.
Sheryl Pringle, County Treasurer reported that there are 3 CD's reaching maturity on January 30. Jason Willberg moved to reinvest those CD's. F. A. Green seconded. Motion carried.
18. Discussion and/or action concerning Resolution Approving VOCA Grant #4240506.
Commissioner Wuebker moved to approve the Resolution approving VOCA Grant #4240506. Commissioner Green seconded. Motion carried.
19. Discussion and/or action concerning Resolution Approving VAWA Grant #4257706.
Commissioner Wuebker moved to approve the Resolution approving the VAWA Grant #4257706. Commissioner Albright seconded. Motion carried.
20. Discussion and/or action concerning approval of UC DY 15 IGT (indigent health care) payment in the amount of \$96,568.87.
Commissioner Green moved to approve the indigent health care payment in the amount of \$96,568.87. Commissioner Albright seconded. Motion carried.
21. Discussion and/or action concerning Constable Pct. 1's 2025 racial profiling report.
Commissioner Albright moved to accept the 2025 racial profiling report from Constable Precinct #1. Commissioner Green seconded. Motion carried.
22. Discussion and/or action concerning approval of compensatory time payout for one (1) jail employee.
Commissioner Green moved to approve the compensatory payment. Commissioner Albright seconded. Motion carried.
23. Discussion and/or action concerning establishing distinct overtime pay expense line items within FY 2026 department budgets.
After an explanation from Georgie Patterson, County Auditor of the need for this change, Commissioner Willberg moved to have the line items created. Commissioner Albright seconded. Motion carried.
24. Discussion and/or action concerning speed limit signs for CR 443.
Following a discussion regarding the speed, Commissioner Wuebker moved to lower the speed limit on the entirety of County Road 443 to 45 miles per hour. Commissioner Willberg seconded. Motion carried.

25. Review and discussion of Road and Bridge precinct work reports, including Administrator's progress report. The department currently has a full staff. Jeff received emails from FEMA, and they will begin making payments.
26. Discussion and/or action concerning the approving of payment of bills, including reimbursements, late charges, the transfer of cash or funds from any line item or departments to another, book transfers and any budget amendments; including but not limited to discussion and action concerning department or non-departmental items with line items that go past their budgeted amounts.
Following a discussion, Milton Albright moved to approve the payment of the bills. Jason Willberg seconded. Motion carried.
27. Approval of minutes of prior meetings of Commissioner's Court.
Commissioner Wuebker moved to approve the minutes as presented. Commissioner Albright seconded. Motion carried. PTE
