COMMISSIONER MINUTES FOR FEBRUARY 9, 2026

- 1. Proof of posting of notice in accordance with the provisions of Title 5, Chapter 551, Government Code (Vernon's Texas Codes Ann. 1994) as amended, known as the Texas Open Meetings Act.

Judge Elliott asked for proof of posting and the same was affirmed by Elizabeth Perez, County Clerk, on the north and south door and the 2nd floor bulletin board.

- 2. Public comments.

Wally Burns commented at the election training, the comment was made that we are one of the only counties that has the best cooperation between the republican party and the democrat party.

- 3. Elected official reports.

No comments.

- 4. Discussion and/or action concerning Operation and Maintenance of Cow Bayou Watershed.

Commissioner Wuebker made a motion to approve the Operation and Maintenance of Cow Bayou Watershed. Commissioner Willberg seconded; motion passed unanimously.

- 5. Discussion and/or action concerning returned checks.

Kayci Nehring, Tax Assessor-Collector, stated the DA's office no longer accepts hot checks. Kayci is wanting to know what can be done with the hot checks that they receive. Kayci is going to talk to John Banks and see if he has any suggestions and bring it back to the next meeting.

- 6. Discussion and/or action concerning new CIRA website templates and quote.

Kelly Szelestey, County Court Coordinator, asked if we can bring this back to the next meeting, she would like to check on a few things before it is approved.

- 7. Discussion and/or action concerning renewing the Sheriff App.

Commissioner Willberg made a motion to renew the Sheriff App; funds will come from the inmate welfare fund. Commissioner Green seconded; motion passed unanimously.

- 8. Discussion and/or action concerning service and maintenance agreement for the jail camera system.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to approve the platinum package for the service and maintenance agreement for the jail camera system; funds will come from the commissary fund. Commissioner Green seconded; motion passed unanimously.

9. Discussion and/or action concerning approving county official's bonds.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to approve the county official's bond. Commissioner Willberg seconded; motion passed unanimously.

10. Discussion and/or action concerning approval of the ARTS annual renewal agreement through the Texas Association of Counties.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to approve the ARTS annual renewal agreement through the Texas Association of Counties. Commissioner Green seconded; motion passed unanimously.

11. Discussion and/or action concerning quarterly investment report.

Sheryl Pringle, County Treasurer, presented the quarterly investment report. Sheryl stated she received pilot payments from BPL Crown Solar for \$57,300 and BPL Sol Solar for \$57,300. She would like to take the total and divide it equally between Texas CLASS and TexSTAR investment pools.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to accept the quarterly investment report and to approve the investments as presented by Sheryl Pringle. Commissioner Willberg seconded; motion passed unanimously.

12. Discussion and/or action concerning Constable Pct. 4's 2025 racial profiling report.

Commissioner Wuebker made a motion to accept Constable Pct. 4's 2025 racial profiling report. Commissioner Green seconded; motion carried.

13. Discussion and/or action concerning interlocal agreement with Chilton ISD.

Commissioner Wuebker made a motion to approve the interlocal agreement with Chilton ISD. Commissioner Albright seconded; motion carried.

14. Discussion and/or action concerning speed limit sign for CR 408.

Commissioner Willberg made a motion to approve the resolution, changing the speed limit to 30 mph on CR 408. Commissioner Green seconded; motion passed unanimously.

15. Discussion and/or action concerning the elevator.

Judge Elliott shared that the elevator is fixed and working. The person they sent out to remove the circuit board knew exactly what the issue was and fixed it.

16. Discussion and/or action concerning House Bill 3000.

Information only. Everything was submitted by the deadline.

17. Review and discussion of Road and Bridge precinct work reports, including Administrator's progress report.

Jeff Jackson, Road and Bridge Administrator, gave a report for the Road and Bridge Department. Jeff stated the state has 3 off system bridges to do, CR 372, CR 271, CR 412. The county needs to come up with a project to match the state's project. Jeff has some bridges in mind; he will get prices together. Jeff found a 2017 John Deere blade in San Antonio that he would like to purchase for \$95,000. Jeff also stated that they had a close-out meeting with FEMA and there is one more paper that needs to be submitted, then we will receive payment.

Commissioner Albright made a motion to approve the purchase on 2017 John Deere Blade. Commissioner Willberg seconded; motion passed unanimously. The motion will be ratified in the next commissioner's court meeting.

18. Discussion and/or action concerning the approving of payment of bills, including reimbursements, late charges, the transfer of cash or funds from any line item or departments to another, book transfers and any budget amendments; including but not limited to discussion and action concerning department or non-departmental items with line items that go past their budgeted amounts.

Commissioner Green made a motion to approve the payment of all bills, budget amendments, and payroll. Commissioner Albright seconded; motion passed unanimously.

19. Approval of minutes of prior meetings of Commissioner's Court.

Commissioner Wuebker made a motion to approve the minutes of the prior meeting. Commissioner Albright seconded; motion passed unanimously.


20. Adjournment.
