COMMISSIONER COURT MINUTES FOR MAY 28, 2019

1. Proof of posting of notice in accordance with the provisions of Title 5, Chapter 551, Government Code (Vernon's Texas Codes Ann. 1994) as amended, known as the Texas Open Meetings Act.

Judge Pro-tem Albright asked for proof of posting & the same was affirmed by Linda Watkins, County Clerk, on the North & South doors & also on the bulletin board. Judge Elliott was absent.

2. Discussion and/or action concerning courthouse renovation, and location to relocate offices.

Commissioner Green made a motion to approve the bid for a smoke & fire alarm system at \$28,000. The funds will be taken out of the courthouse renovation loan. Commissioner Willberg seconded. Motion carried.

3. Discussion and/or action concerning hospital program, Save a Life.

13. Adjournment.



Judge Pro-tem Albright adjourned the meeting since all items have been discussed and/or action taken.
