Order Adopting 2024 Tax Rate for Falls County

"I move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of .73509 which is effectively an 7.68% (percentage by which the proposed tax rate exceeds the effective tax rate) percent decrease in the tax rate." Tax Code 26.05(b)

"THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE," Tax Code 26.05(b)(1)(A)

Whereas, the Falls County Commissioners Court find it necessary to increase the tax rate levied by 7.68% for 2024 in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the County, and to pay expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the County to Falls County residents: therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT:

That there is hereby levied and there shall be assessed and collected for 2024 an ad valorem tax of \$0.73509

per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the county as shown on the final approved 2024 tax rolls of the county.
